ADMISSION POLICY: Potential students need to refer to the Admission Policy for the Dental Hygiene Program prior to applying to the program.

ATTENTION: Dental Hygiene students must complete BIOL 1545 before the Fall Semester of the first year in the program with a "C" grade or better. Courses must be completed by the end of the semester that they are listed, except for SOCIO 1500, ENGL 1550 & ENGL 1551. ENGL 1551 must be completed by the end of Fall Semester of the second year.

PROGRAM POLICY: Students will be dismissed from the Dental Hygiene Program if they:

- Earn an "F" in any DENHY, CHEM, BIOL or CLTEC courses; or
- Earn a total of 8 hours of "D" grades in DENHY, CHEM, BIOL or CLTEC courses; or
- Earn a total of 6 hours of "D" grades in DENHY courses; or
- Fail to maintain an overall grade point average of 2.0 or higher.

Students who are dismissed, will not be readmitted into the Dental Hygiene Program.

NOTE: When "D" grades are earned in first year dental hygiene didactic courses, they must be repeated in the following academic year. There are no opportunities to repeat clinical courses if a student plans to stay on schedule and graduate within two years; therefore, deficiencies in clinical courses must be completed within the regular clinical sequence.

Students who have not been dismissed and are entering the second year with "D" grades, or students who earn "D" grades in the second year of the program, will be assigned remedial work and a supervising instructor. This will be done for the purpose of enhancing their ability to complete the program. When courses that are repeated and passed with a "C" grade or better, and a repetition of grade change has been processed and recorded, the accumulative hours of "D"/"F" grades will be reduced according to the credit hours of the course(s).

The University reserves the right to dismiss the student who is unable or unwilling to achieve the scholastic, ethical, and/or professional standards of the University and the Dental Hygiene Program.
